Austin ISD has called for a bond for the Nov. 8, 2022 election that would fund critical repairs across the district, upgrades to safety and security, 25 school modernizations and additional upgrades to technology, transportation and athletics.

### Austin ISD Anticipates Lowering the School Tax Rate By 9.5 Cents Over Two Years

The proposed bond package is expected to raise the debt service portion of the school tax rate by 1 cent per \$100 in taxable value. However, Austin ISD plans to reduce the maintenance and operations portion of the school tax rate by 6.5 cents this year due to rising property values. This bond proposal will not affect the tax rate reduction for this school year, and property owners are expected to see an additional estimated 3-cent reduction in the school tax rate next year, for a total reduction of 9.5 cents by 2023–24.

### 100% of Bond Dollars Invested Locally

Unlike maintenance tax revenue, bond dollars are not subject to recapture by the state so every cent of every dollar raised would be invested in Austin ISD schools and facilities.
