

# Central Athletic Facilities 2022 Bond FAQs

#### **FAQs for all Central Athletic Facilities**

- 1. How will construction impact the current sport programming? Will they have to relocate to another location during construction?
  - The safety of students, staff, and community members during construction is our top priority. In order to achieve this, we will temporarily relocate programs to a nearby location. More details regarding the logistics of the relocation will be provided to community members and program participants.
- 2. How will construction impact neighbors who live near the facilities? Neighbors in the immediate area surrounding the facilities will be notified before the start of construction and will be made aware of any major changes during construction. While every project is different, activities to expect may include; temporary fencing installed around the active construction site, trucks entering and exiting the primary construction area; neighbors may hear backup alarms while equipment and trucks are on site. There will also be hammering, drilling and other general construction equipment noises.
- 3. What happens to the contents of a facility that is being renovated?

  Austin ISD is committed to sustainability and recycles or re-purposes as much as possible from facilities that are being modernized or remodeled.
- 4. Which central athletic facilities will receive improvements as part of the 2022 Bond?

As part of the 2022 Bond program, the following facilities will receive improvements:

- Burger Athletic Complex
- Delco Center
- Nelson Field
- Noack Sports Complex
- Yellow Jacket Stadium
