FAQs for High School Athletic Turf & Fields

1. Which schools will receive new artificial turf and upgrades to their sports fields as part of the 2022 Bond?

As part of the 2022 Bond program, the high schools below will receive upgrades to their athletic fields. These projects are primarily used for high school athletics while also supporting middle school games and track meets. They will also provide space for marching band competitions and training and use for PE as required.

Anderson HS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
Austin HS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
Bowie HS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
Crockett ECHS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball

LBJ ECHS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
LASA	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
McCallum HS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
Navarro ECHS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
Northeast ECHS/ International HS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball
Travis ECHS	Artificial turf, scoreboard, resurface track, lights, seating, concessions and restrooms at football/soccer and lights at baseball/softball

2. Will any of these schools have any other improvements to their athletic spaces as part of the 2022 Bond?

3. What is the timeline for improvements at each school?

Design is in progress on the turf and field improvements on all of the schools listed above. Construction schedules are still being confirmed, as design progresses and each site is permitted.

4. How do I get involved with the project and provide input?

A Campus Architectural Team (CAT) has been formed to provide input on the projects. Members include principals and athletic coordinators from each campus and central athletics staff. CAT meetings are open to the public and up to five minutes of public comment will be allowed per meeting with a limit of one minute per speaker. Those meeting dates and times will be published on the calendar at AISDFuture.com once they are confirmed.
